The wait is over. On October 24, the Social Security Administration announced the COLA for 2026. Will it allow retirees to keep up with increasing costs? Critics say no.

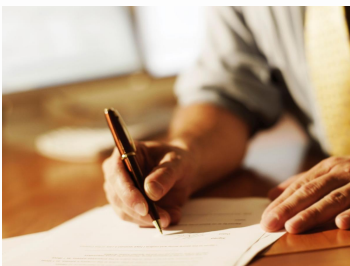
